



## Professor Christopher Ziguras

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Chris's work focuses on the globalisation of education and training, particularly the ways in which regulatory agencies, markets, education providers and other actors shape cross-border provision of higher education. This interest is carried across his higher education leadership, diverse management roles at RMIT, prominent research on cross-border higher education, teaching in international development and public policy, and his active public engagement. He was President of the International Education Association of Australia 2015-18. Chris is Chair of CHEI's Academic Board, and is also affiliated with the Australian APEC Study Centre at RMIT and the Centre for the Study of Higher Education at the University of Melbourne.
